

## ECMI Seeking Interns

### Description

ECMI seeks interns for the period April-September 2013 to support new ECMI initiatives in the research areas of

- Performance indicators for minority rights impact,
- The definition of minority
- Minorities and the environment

At this point, one intern position per research area is open. It is possible to apply for all three areas. Applicants are kindly requested to indicate in order of priority their preference for research areas. The main task of the interns will be to assist the principal investigators in each area in planning and organizing a workshop. In addition, the interns are expected to independently compile bibliographies and documents in the areas of research as well as in compiling an expert roster.

### Payment

The internship positions are unpaid and the ECMI is not able to cover travel expenses. However, there is a possibility to remunerate some interns through the Flensburg Stadt Fellowship which provides accommodation in an apartment supplied by the Flensburg Town Hall for ECMI interns. Please consider that the number of rooms at the apartment is limited.
